

# ERTS TEST SITE LOCATION MAPS

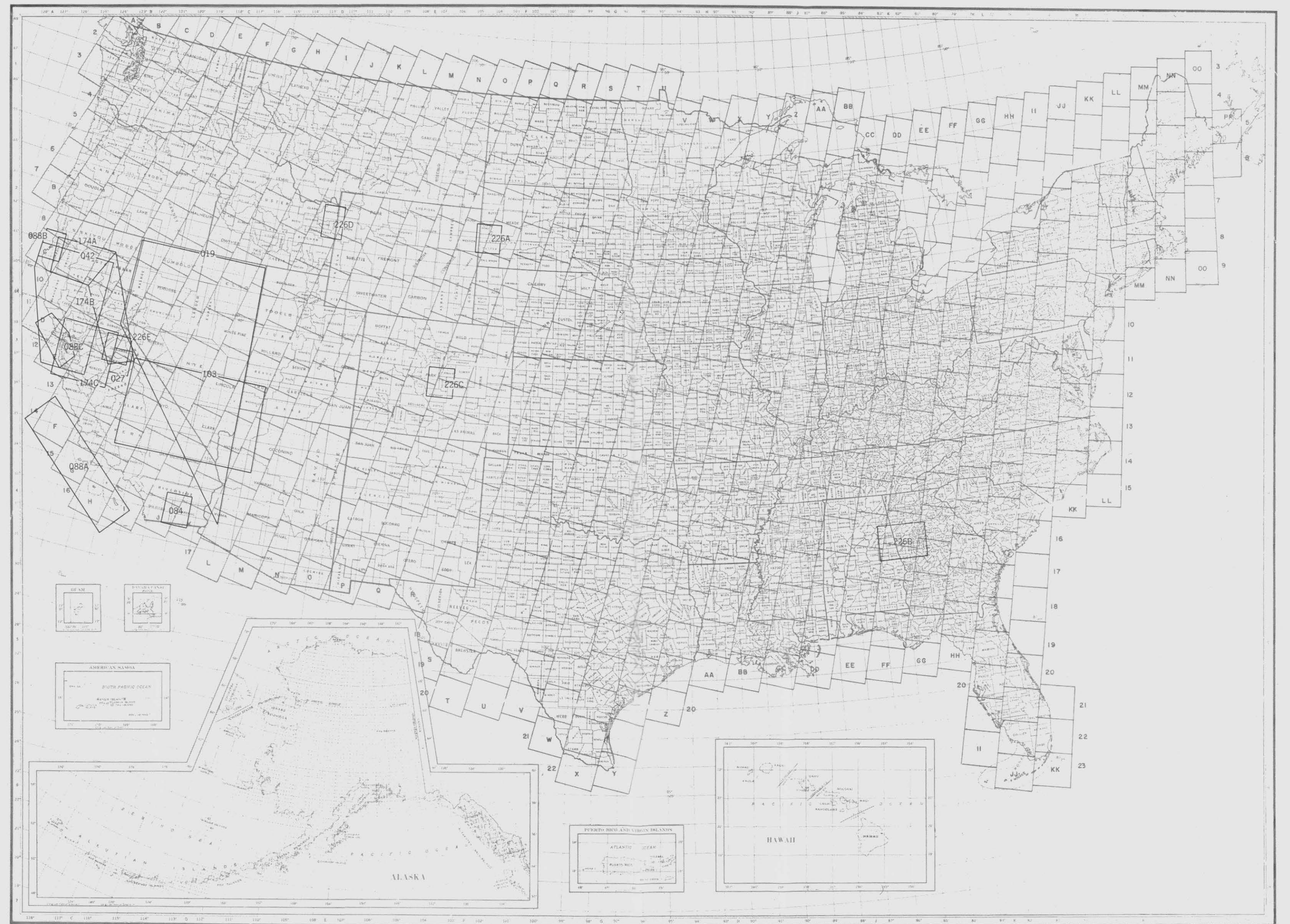
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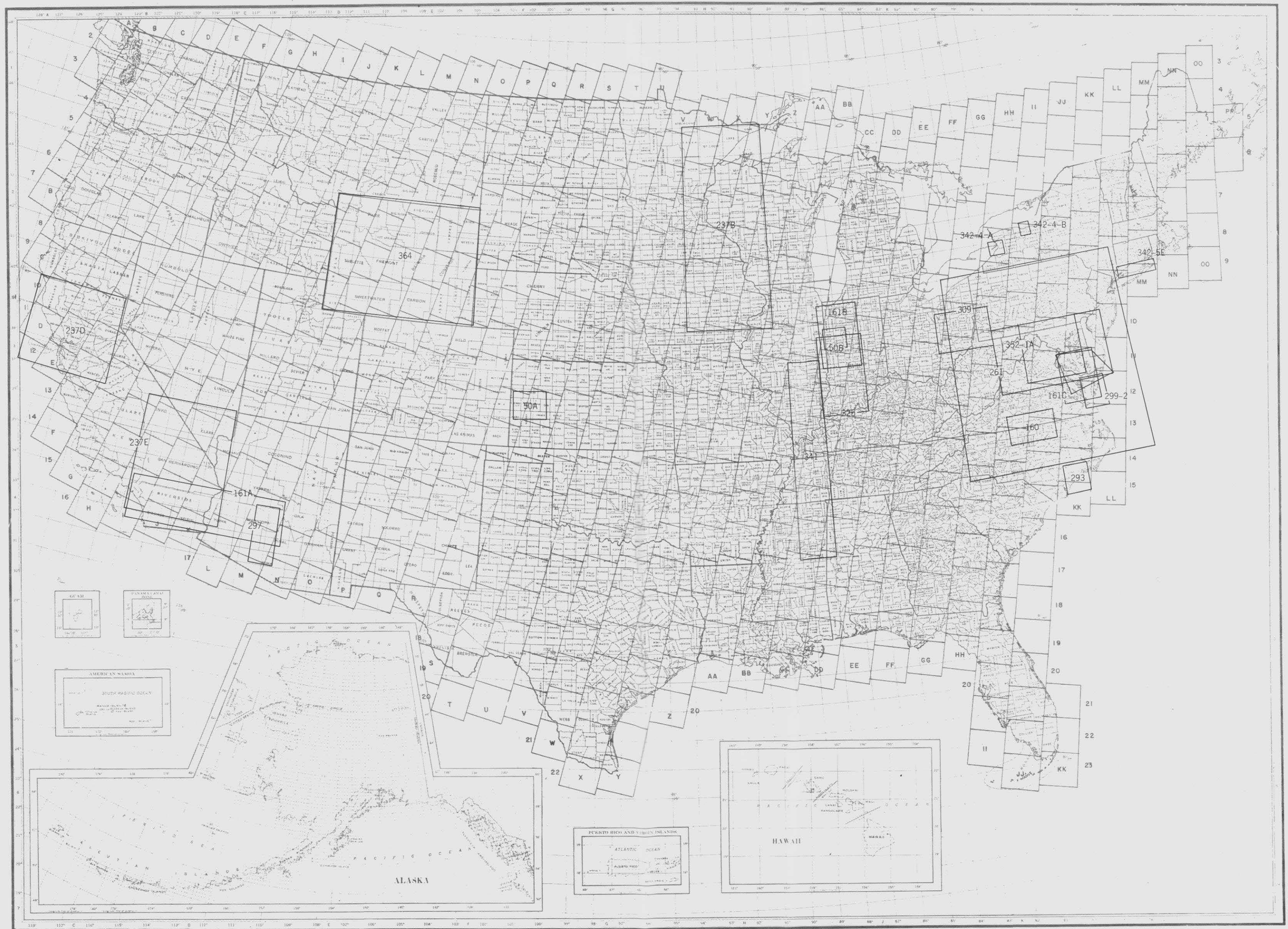
The maps contained here are presented for the purpose of showing the test site coverage presently known. Test site coverage for many proposals is not represented on these maps because the necessary information was not available. These maps will be updated when the coverage information is determined to be accurate and complete.

The composite map of the U.S. is presented to show the complete coverage on one map. The areas of coverage which have been requested are outlined by heavy lines. Each proposal represented on the map is indicated by the proposal number located at the approximate center of the test site specified by the proposal.

Test site location and configuration can be determined for any of the available proposals by locating the proposal number on a detailed map which contains the geographical location for the test site.

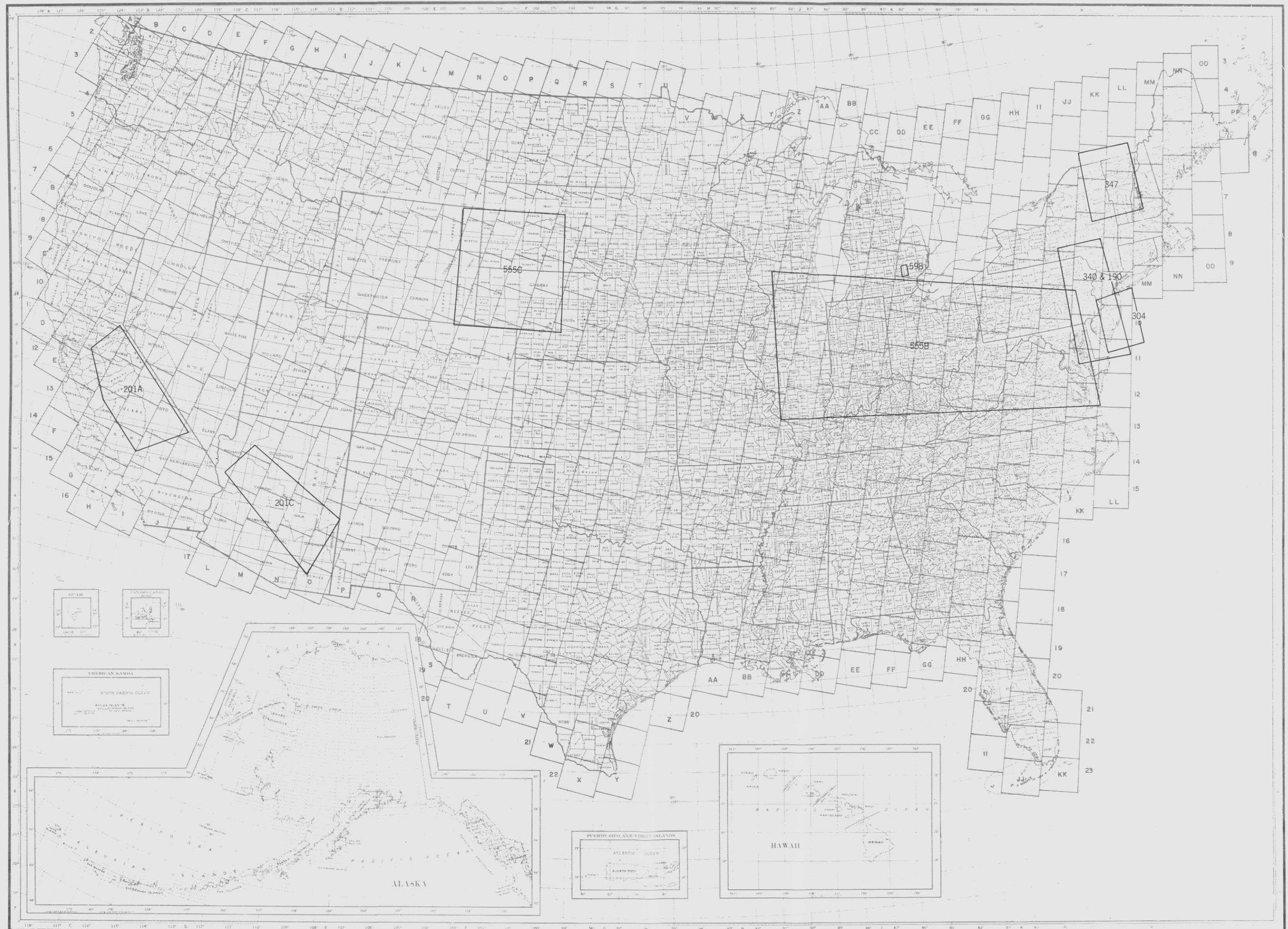


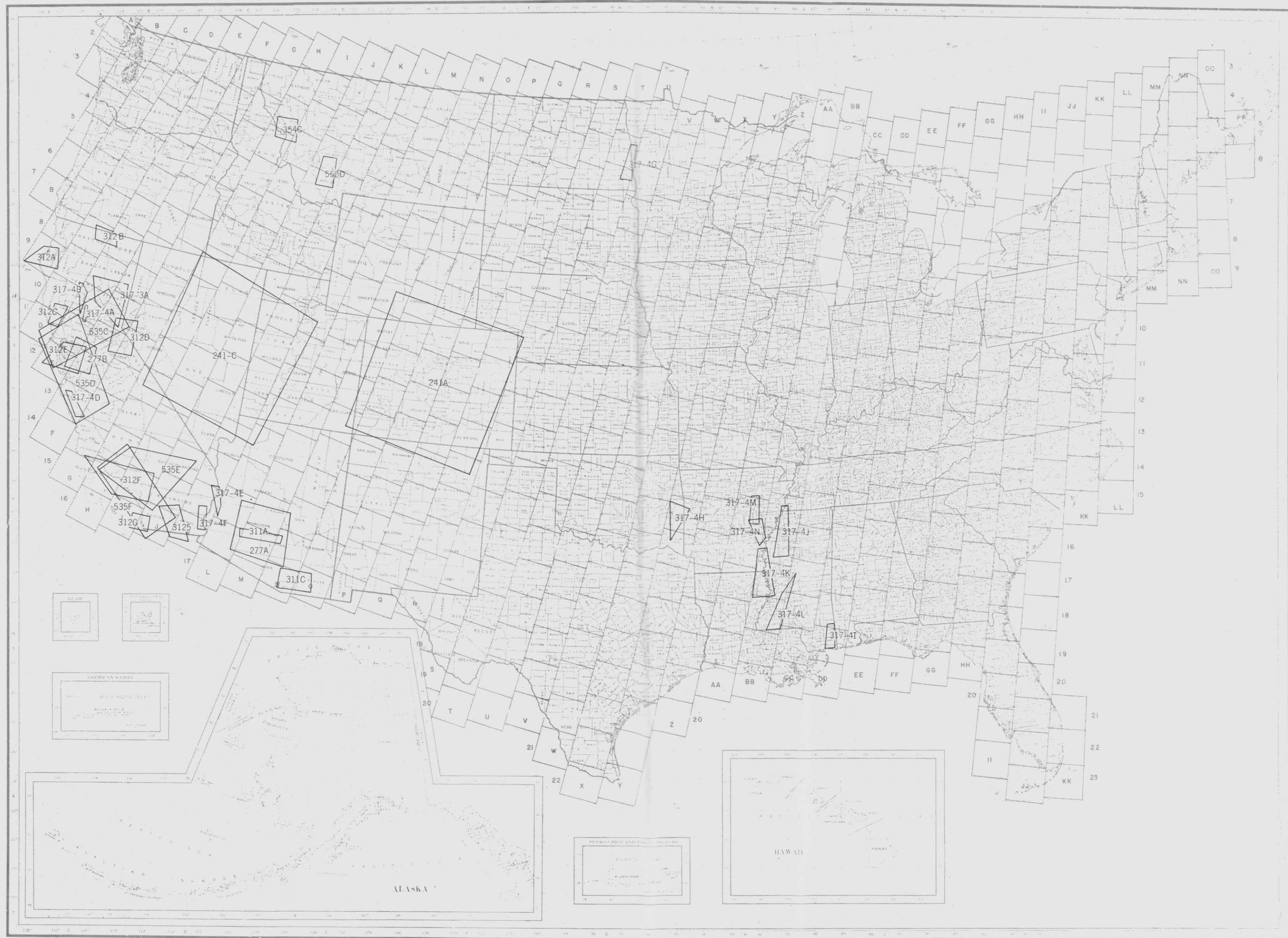


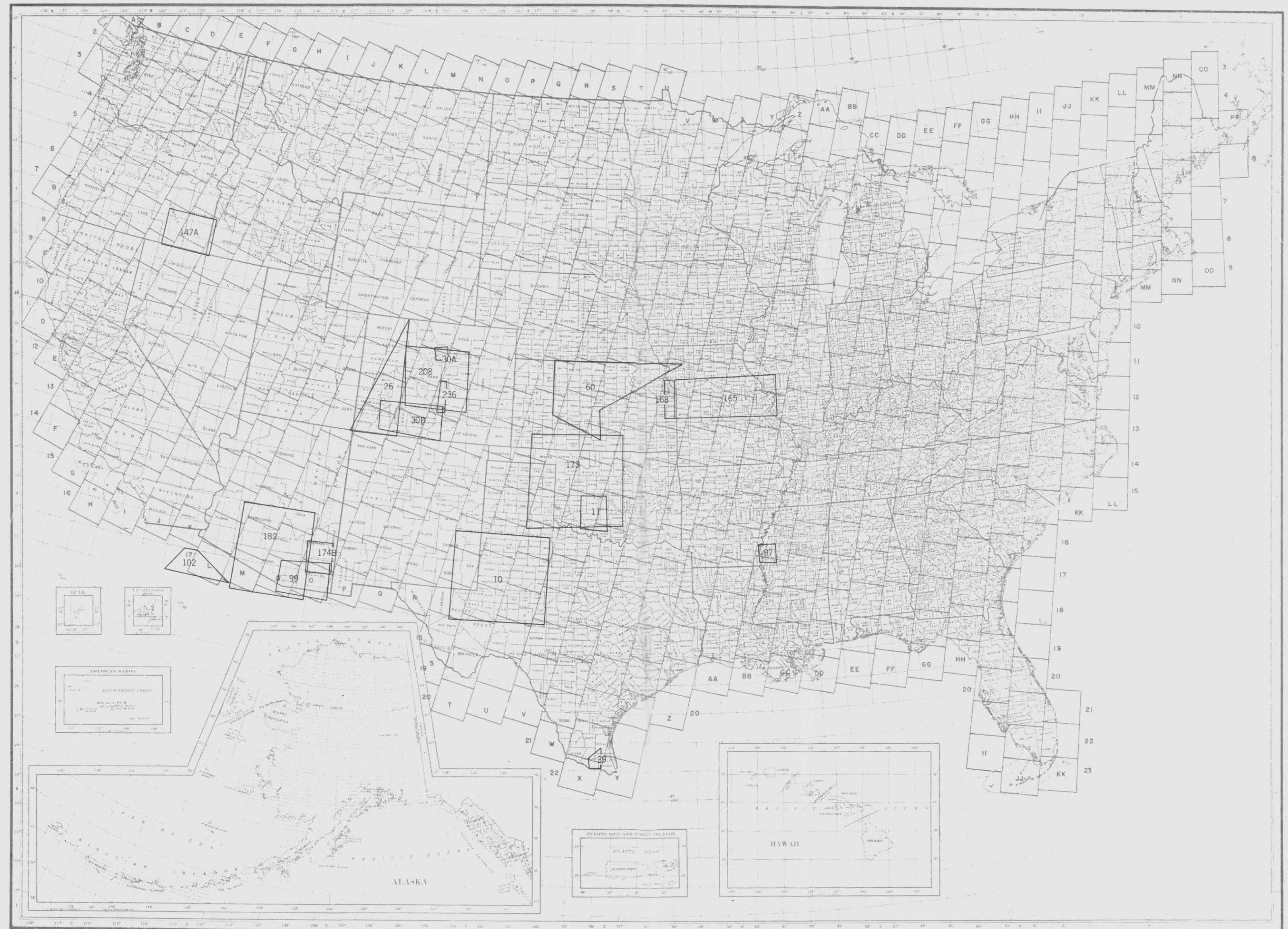


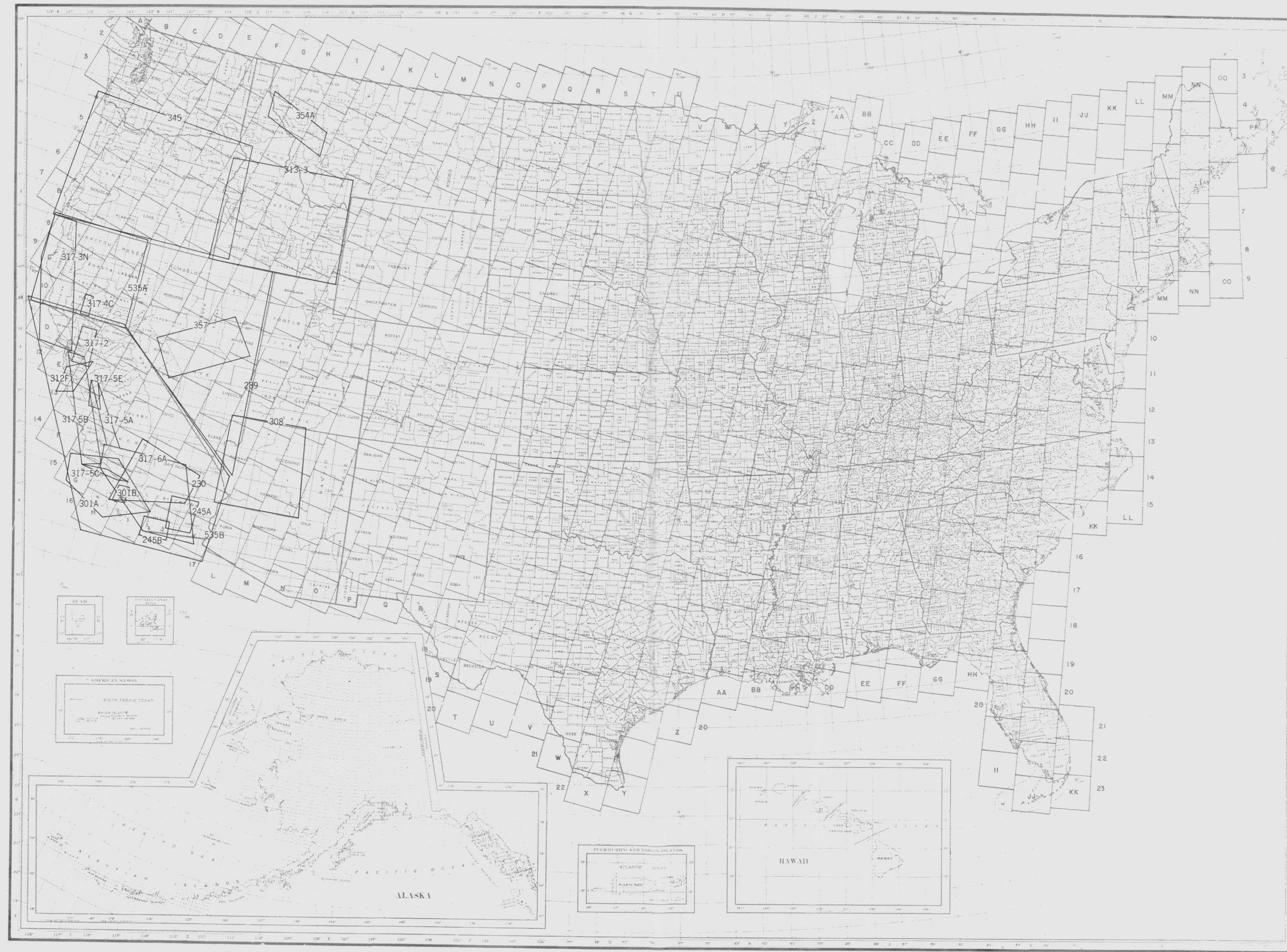


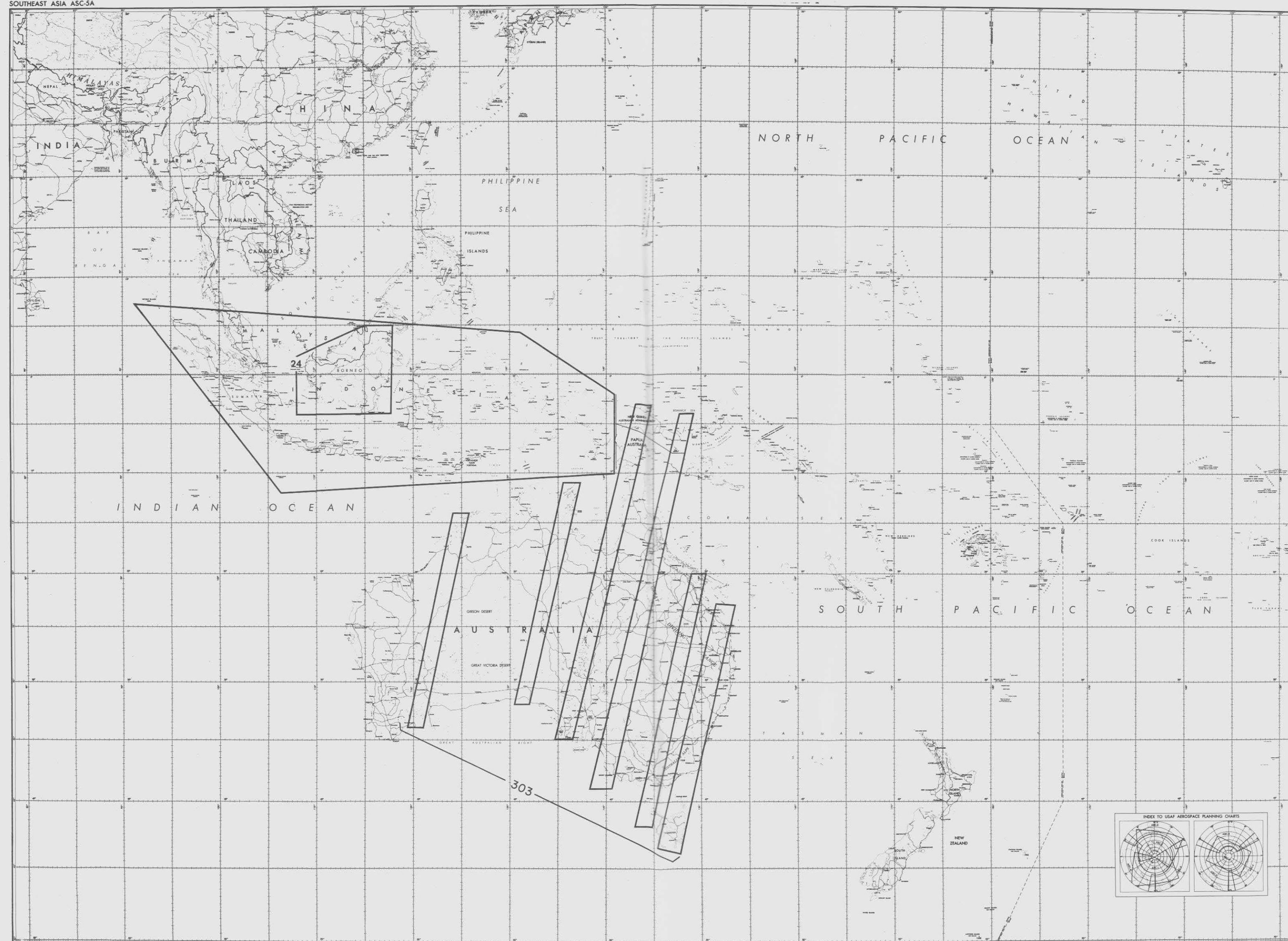




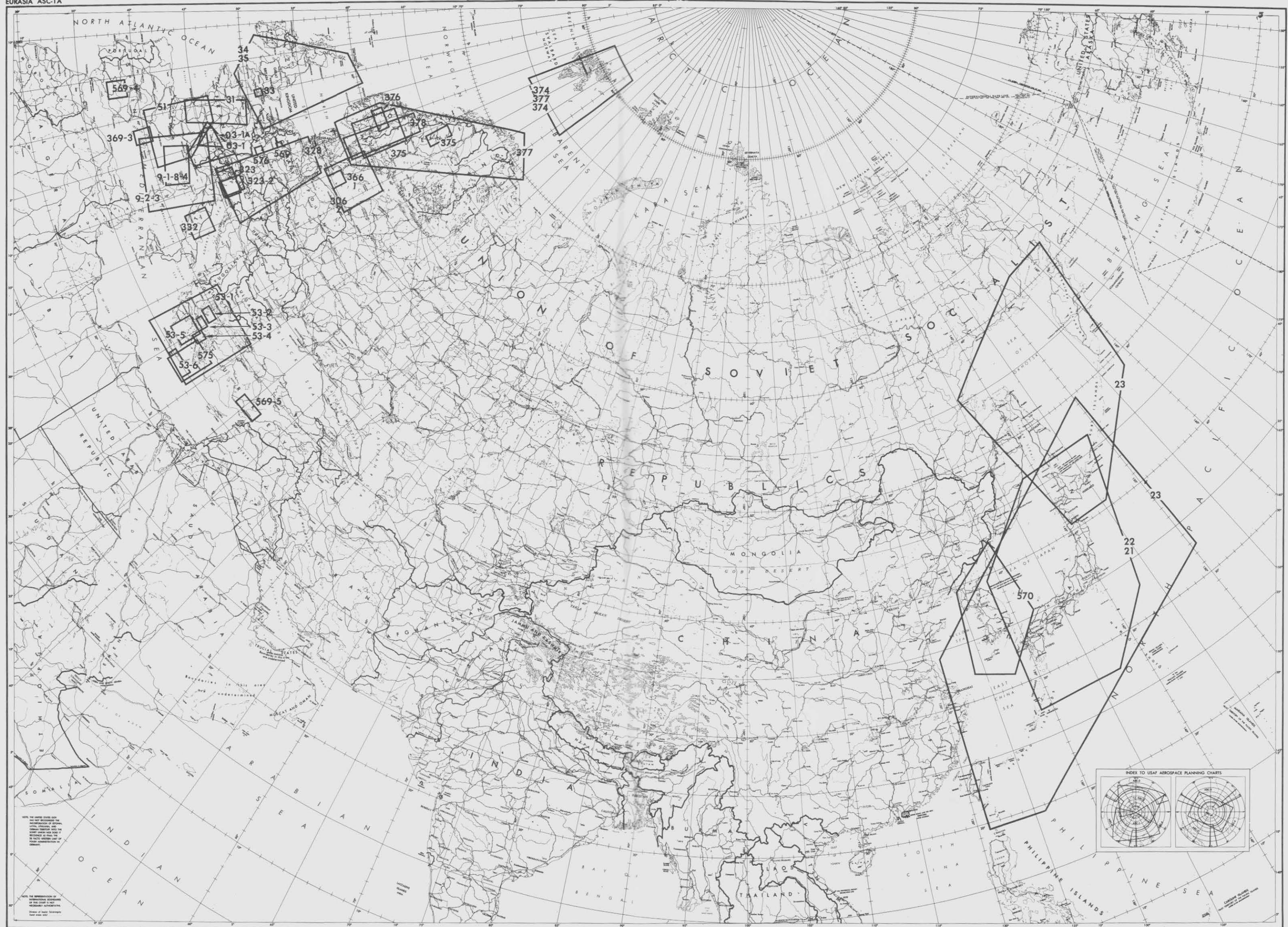
